

Process for Applying for a School of Surgery Training Award

Background

Core surgical trainees are expected to achieve the necessary competencies outlined on the ISCP website (www.ISCP.ac.uk-Syllabus-CoreSurgicalTraining2010) and the School of Surgery Training Awards have been designed to reward trainees who achieve more than the necessary competencies and show an outstanding level of engagement with the requirements of the North Western Deanery Core Surgical Trainee Teaching Programme.

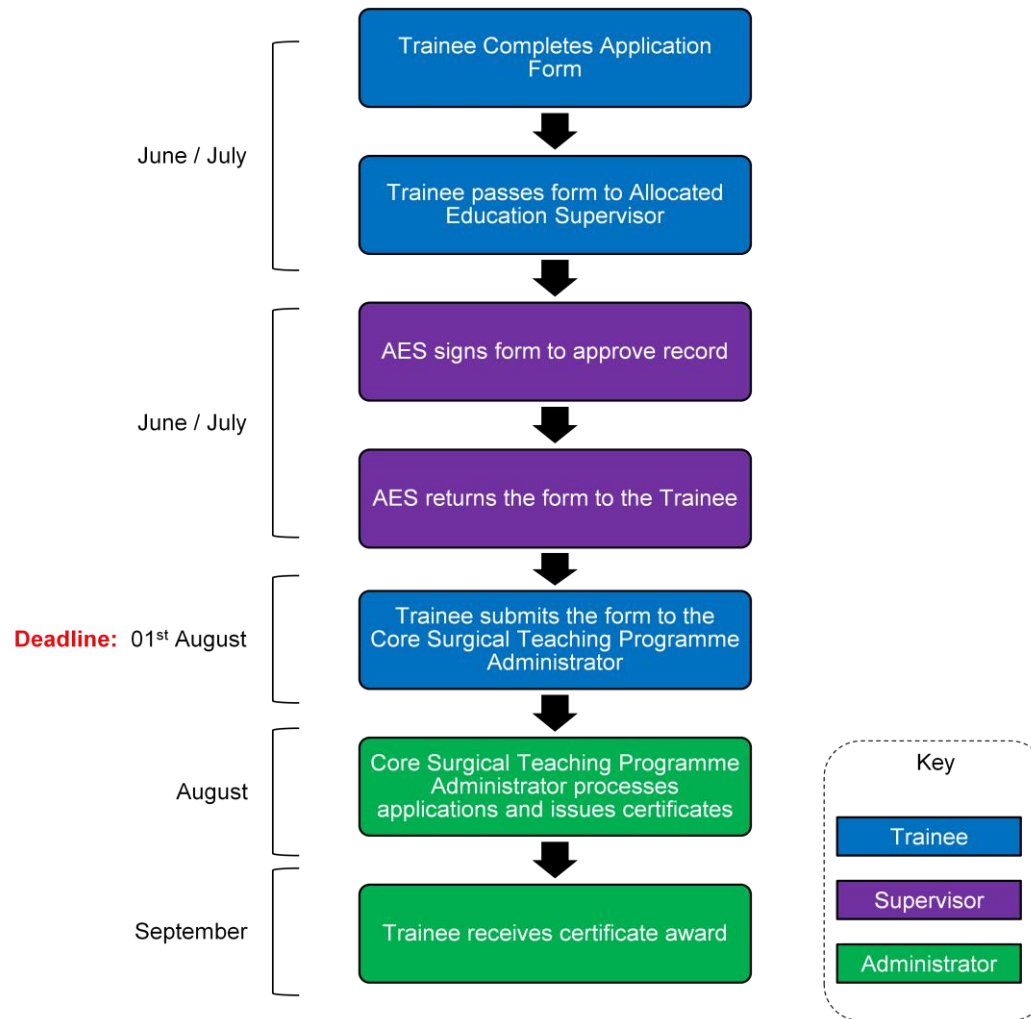
Introduction

To apply for an award an application must be completed at the end of the year by the trainee and signed by the Allocated Educational Supervisor as an accurate record of training. This application will then be reviewed by the Head of School, Core Surgical Education Lead and the Core Surgical Teaching Administrator **and certificates** will be awarded in September which can be included in the trainee portfolio and can be used as evidence of achievement in application for other posts.

Appeals

If a trainee does not meet the credit criteria but still feels they have exceptional circumstances, then they must send an email explaining their case to the Education Administrator for Core Surgical Training: (<https://www.nwpgmd.nhs.uk/specialties/content/key-contacts-67> - DeanerySupport) who will arrange for their case to be considered at the next Core Surgical Training Committee meeting.
