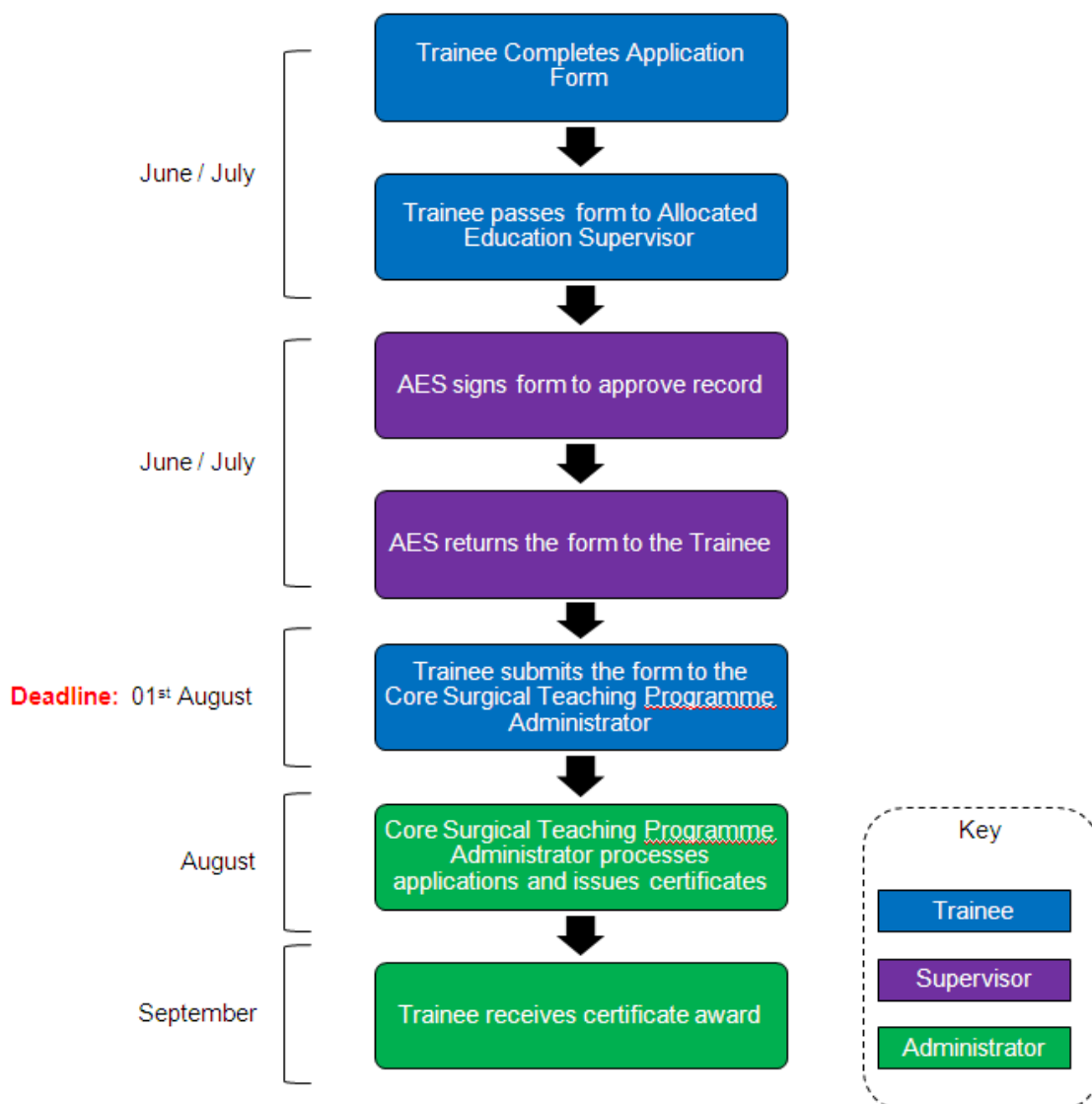


School of Surgery Training Awards
